Due to the recent updates in the CDC guidelines, the WACOC COVID protocols are being adjusted as shown below. If the virus resurges in our community, please understand that further guidelines and possibly public gathering restrictions may go back into place. We ask that you take personal responsibility in following these guidelines.

FACILITY PROTOCOLS FOR NON-WORSHIP AND WORSHIP ACTIVITIES:

- If you have any Covid symptoms or other illnesses, we encourage you not to come to the building.
- Masks are optional, we ask that everyone be considerate of others.
- Individuals or groups can use the building during non-service times. We ask that you inform the office that you are in the building. For group events, please fill out and submit the Use of Church's Facilities Request Form (available at wacoc.org / members area / forms) to the office.
- Those with facility reservations are asked to limit their use of the building to the areas requested in their specific reservation.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR WORSHIP ATTENDERS:

- We will use only the glass doors to the main lobby to enter and exit the church building.
- We will not pass the communion or contribution trays. Pre-packaged communion kits will be available when you enter the Foyer, or you can bring your own communion if you prefer.
- A contribution box will be at the back of the auditorium in which you can place your contribution. Electronic contribution is also available at wacoc.org.
- The Nursery will be available to parents; however, we ask parents to take care of the needs of their children and return to services. There will not be attendants in the nursery.

SHOULD I ATTEND SERVICES AT THE BUILDING?

- If you have any current Covid symptoms or other illnesses, we encourage you to remain home and to worship on livestream.
- If you are over 65 years old, we recommend you continue to assess your own health risk as you make the decision to come or not to come.
- If you have an underlying health issue, or if you have someone in your home that has an underlying health issue; we encourage you to be wise in your personal decision of returning to worship or continuing with livestream.
